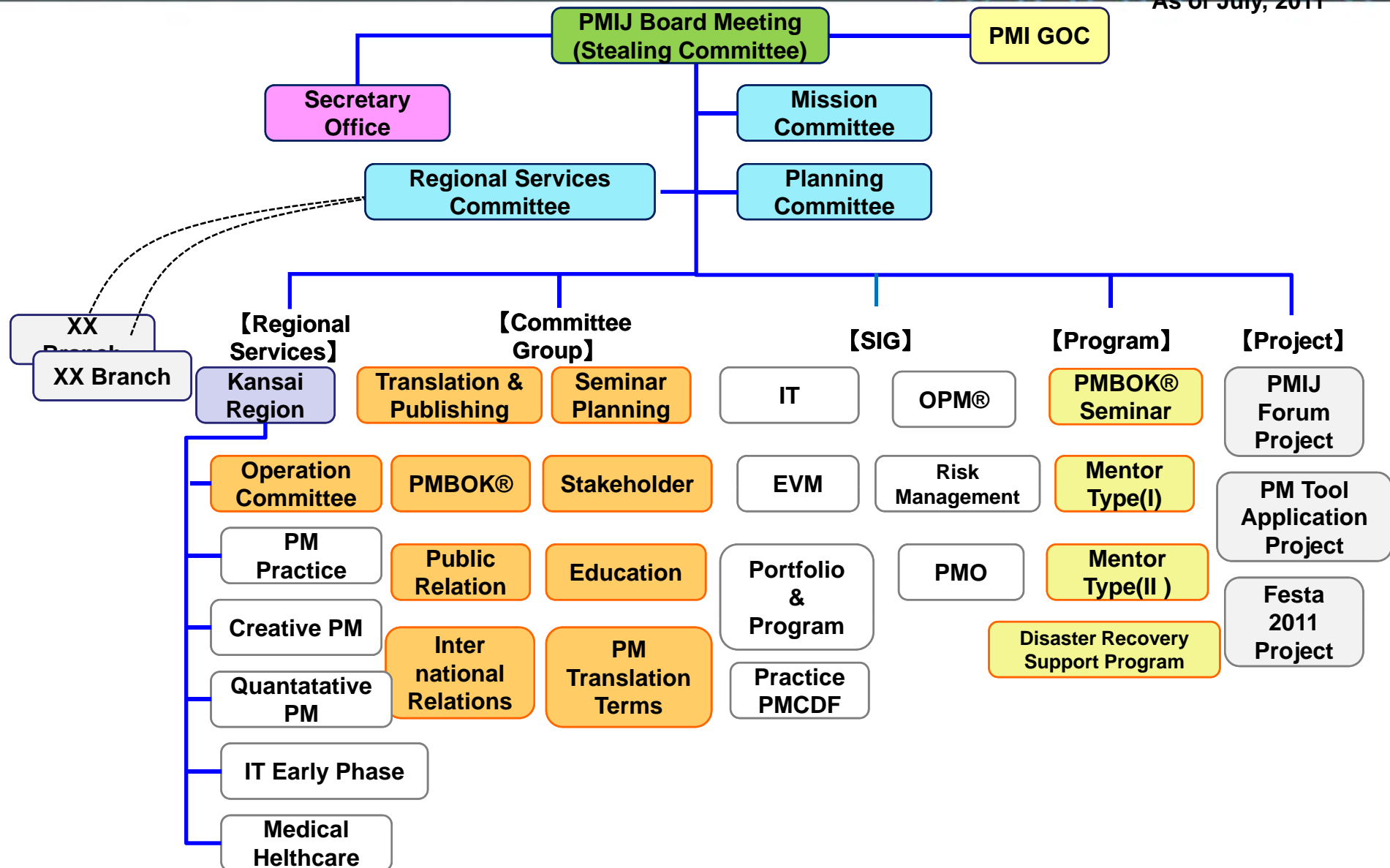

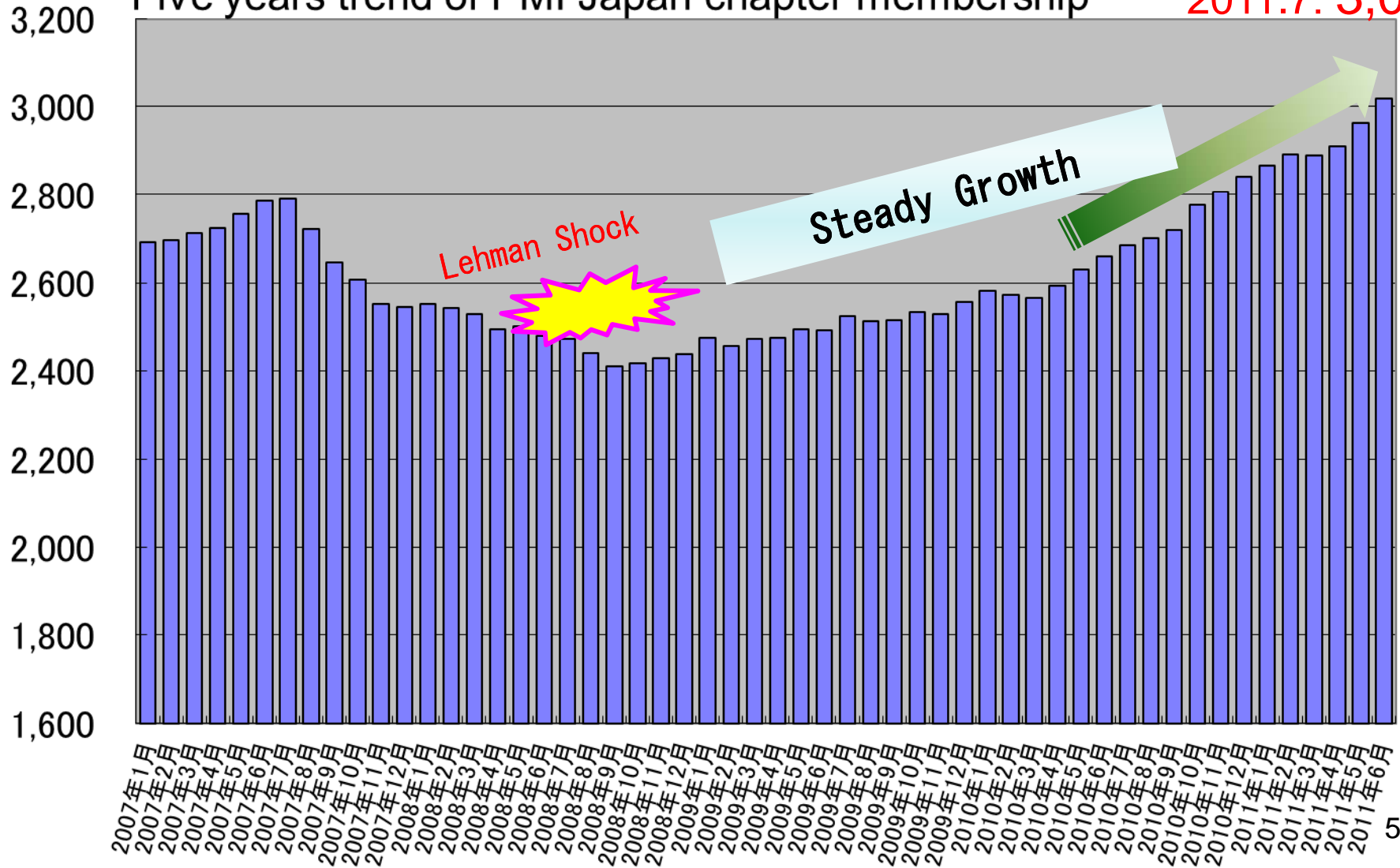

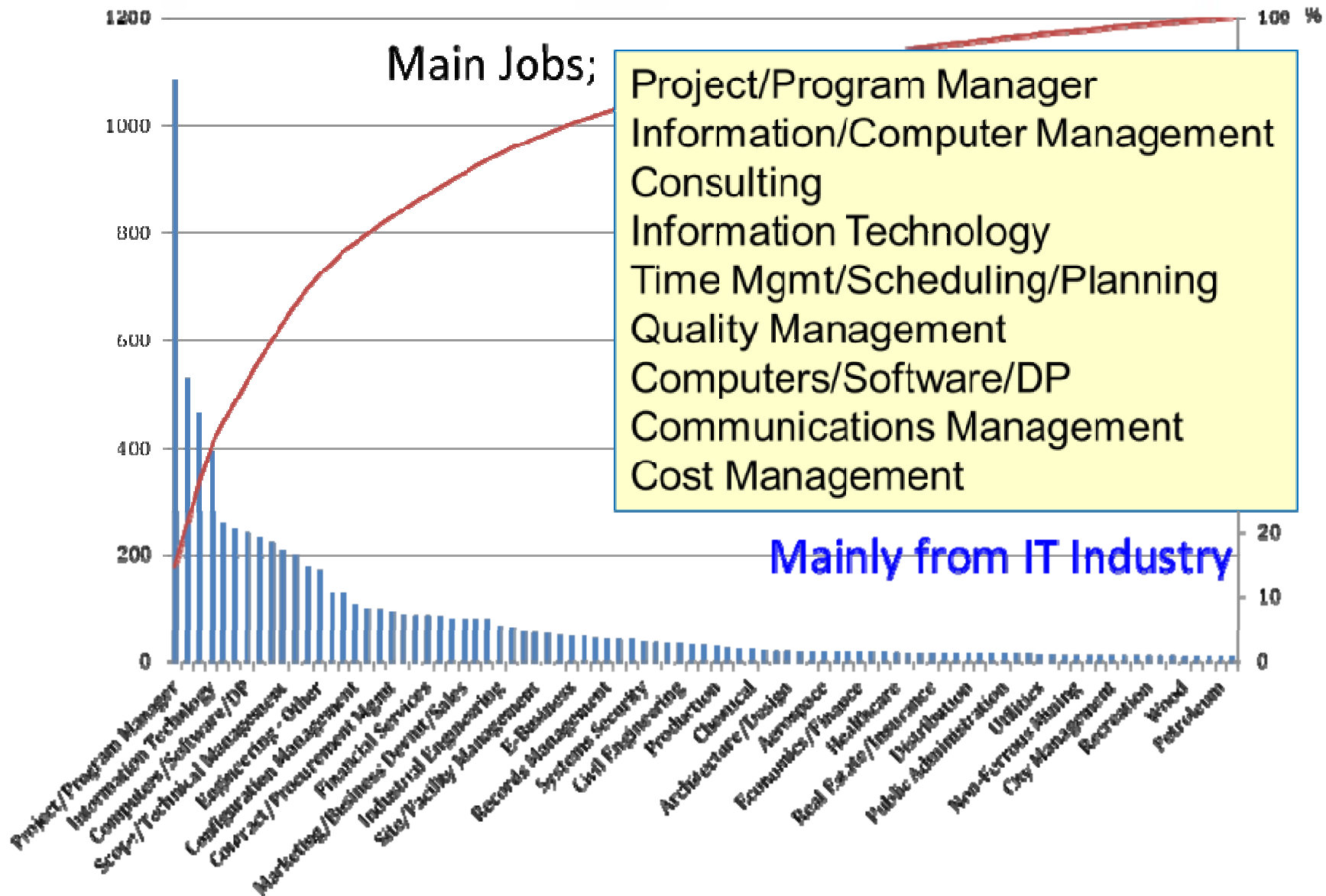

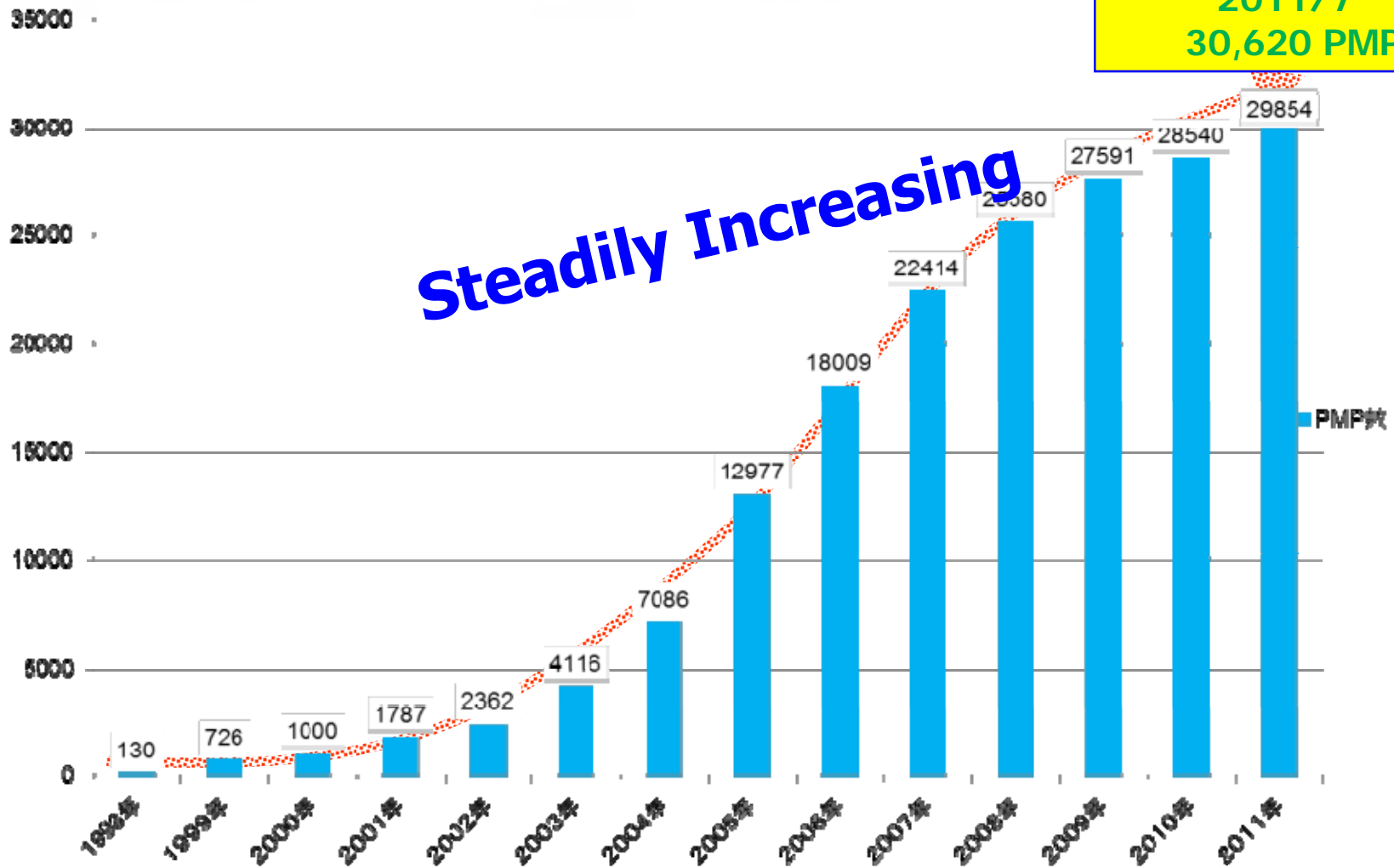
Five years trend of PMI Japan chapter membership

2011.7: 3,049





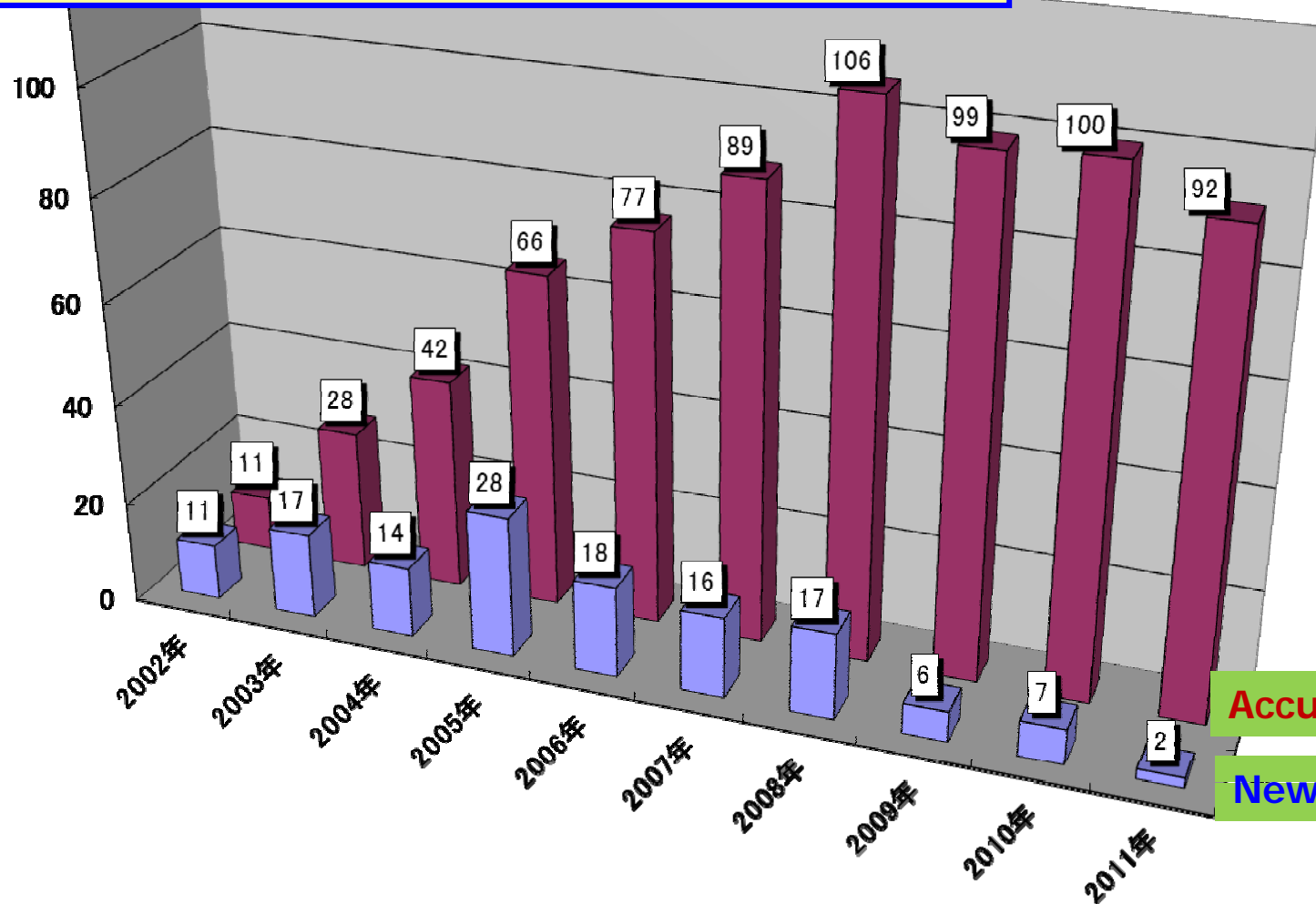
PMP credentials in Japan

1 プロジェクトマネジメント補講(PMP受験対策講座)を開講

春休み中の土曜日5回を使い、PMP®資格受験希望の学生・教員28名が参加し、「プロジェクトマネジメント補講」が行われた。本講座は、当所付准教授が中心となって、約1年の構想の末に実施された。PMP®とは、米国に本部を置く世界最大のプロジェクトマネジメント協会 Project Management Institute によって、プロジェクトマネジメントのスキルを有していることを認定する資格 “Project Management Professional” のことである。世界中で40万人を超える資格保持者がいる。

講師はプロのインストラクター大塚有希子氏(SDM研究科博士課程在籍)を迎え、PMJH本支部公認セミナーとして2月末にスタートしたものの、シリーズ途中で東日本大震災がありスケジュールが大幅に遅延、ようやく4月23日に最終回の模擬テストを終えた。講座修了後すぐに試験に臨んだ3名は全員合格している。

好評だったこの講座、今期は夏休み期間中の開催を目標です。慶應SDMのように、プロジェクトマネジメントをコア科目に据えて、PMP®受験を積極的に支援している大学・大学院は他に例を見ない。これからも多くのPMP®資格者を輩出してまいります。

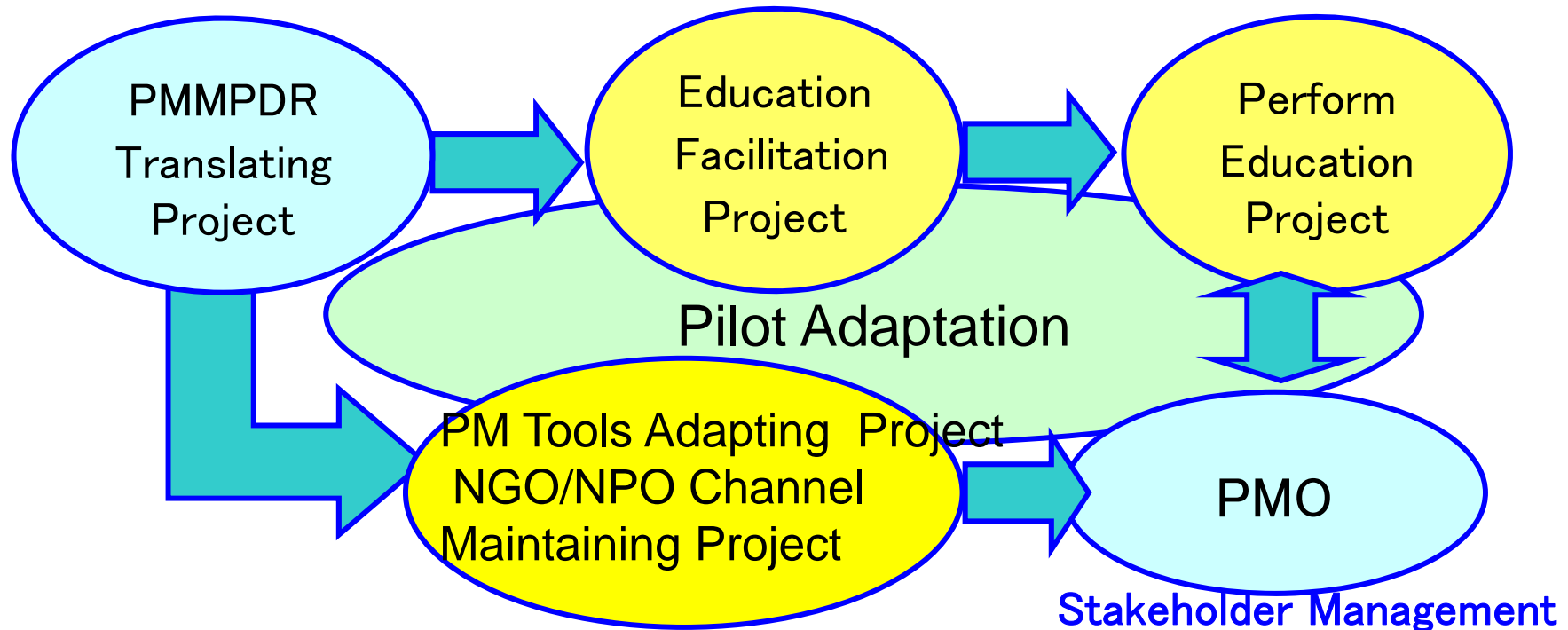
